An artistic exchange between musician F.M. Einheit and media archaeologist Siegfried Zielinski spanned two years, resulting in a critical and sonorous jumble of ideas – sometimes topical, sometimes phantasmagorical, sometimes sound poetry.

"Art is resistance. There is no art without waste," says Siegfried Zielinski. The researcher has been studying media archaeologies and the function of archives for years. "Matter is active. It is subject, not object."

Zielinski and the sound explorer F.M. Einheit accessed their "an archives" for Free Modulations Radio. The sounds they found inside were left to run rampant. A mental drift of quotations from Vilém Flusser to Genesis P-Orridge. Poetry of an artificial intelligence.
